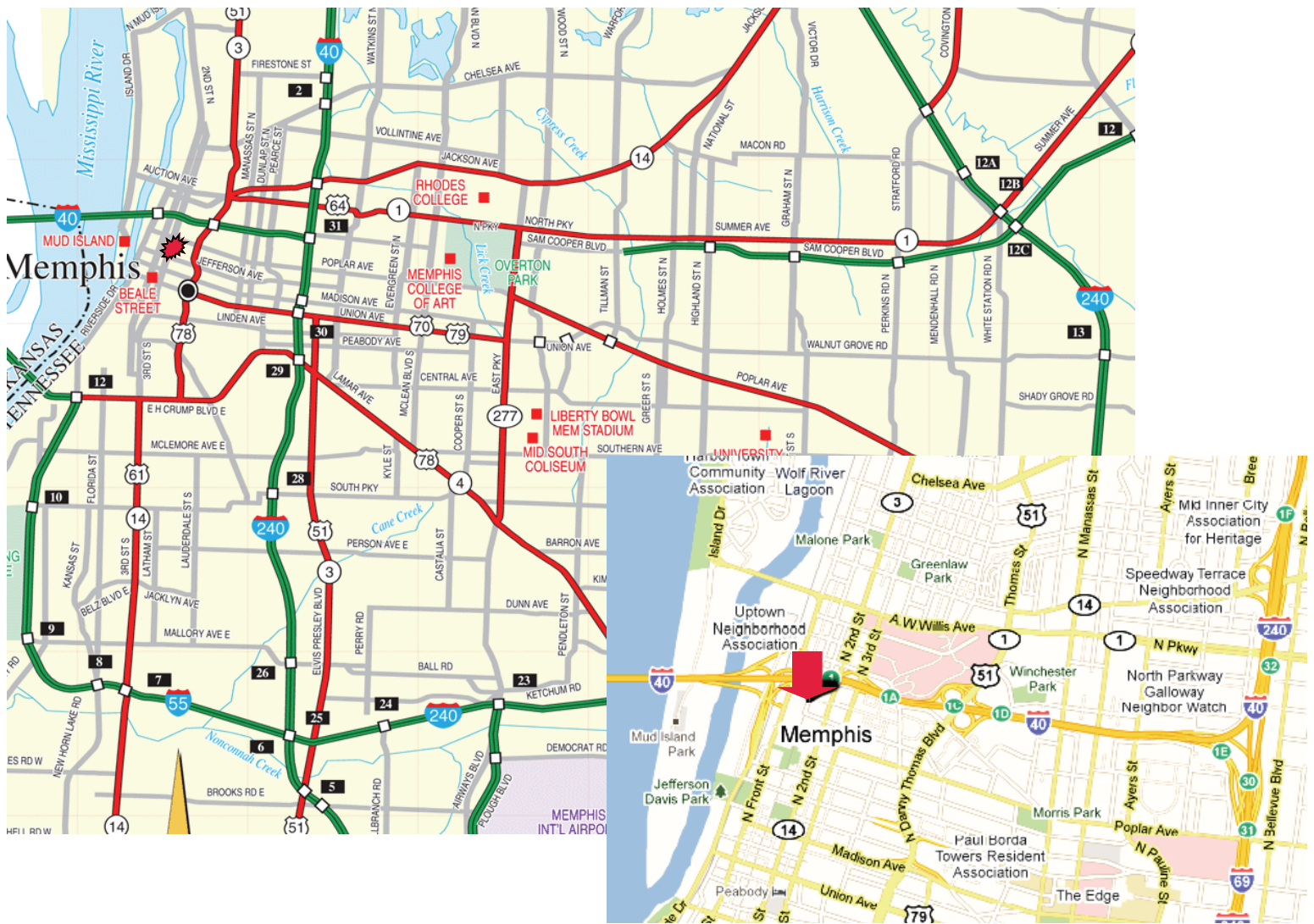

By Highway:

Traveling North on Interstate 55, take Interstate 240N via Exit 6B toward Little Rock approximately 4 miles then merge onto I-40W via Exit 31 toward Little Rock for approximately 1.5 miles. Take Second Street Exit, Exit 1A toward Third Street. Approximately .2 mile turn onto N 2nd St (Tennessee 14S/Tennessee 3S). Almost immediately turn right onto Winchester Ave. (If you reach Market Ave, you've gone too far). In less than a tenth of a mile, turn left onto Main St. Convention Center will be on your right.

Traveling South on Interstate 55, take Interstate 40 E toward Memphis/Nashville for approximately 5.3 miles. Take the Front Street Exit, Exit 1 toward Local Truck Route. In 3-tenths of a mile, turn left onto North Front Street for approximately one mile. Turn right onto Winchester Ave (If you reach Jackson Ave, you've gone too far). In less than a tenth of a mile, turn right on to Main St. Convention Center will be on your right.

Traveling East on Interstate 40, take the Front Street Exit, Exit 1 toward Local Truck Route. In 3-tenths of a mile, turn left onto North Front Street for approximately 1 mile. Turn right onto Winchester Ave (If you reach Jackson Ave, you've gone too far). In less than a tenth of a mile, turn right on to Main St. Convention Center will be on your right.

Traveling West on Interstate 40, take Interstate 40 W via Exit 10B toward Little Rock approximately 13 miles. Take Second Street Exit, Exit 1A toward third Street. Approximately .2 miles then turn onto N 2nd St (Tennessee 14S/Tennessee 3S). Almost immediately turn right onto Winchester Ave. (If you reach Market Ave, you've gone too far). In less than a tenth of a mile, turn left onto Main St. Convention Center will be on your right.

By Air:

Memphis International Airport is just south of the Interstate 240 loop. If renting a car, take Plough north, merge onto west Interstate 240 then merge onto Interstate 55 North and follow the directions as if traveling North on Interstate 55.

RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

SALES TABLES, DISPLAYS, AND EARLY BUYERS

Sales Tables:

The showroom has room for approximately 350 tables. The tables are eight feet long and 30" wide. Cloth table covers will be provided. Tables will be available on a first come basis. Every attempt will be made to honor table location requests. Tables will be assigned based upon the date the contract was received.

The first 8' table will be \$60. Each additional table will be \$45. **FOHBC members** will get a \$15 discount per contract for the first table only. White tablecloths will be furnished at no extra cost. Up to two nametags per contract will be provided (*regardless of the number of tables per contract*) with the exception of minor children. Please make arrangements for children's nametags in advance. **Subletting a table to another dealer or individual is prohibited.**

Merchandise:

The emphasis of your sales table should be antique bottles, jars, flasks, blown glass, insulators, stoneware, related advertising, and new items to assist the hobby (such as price guides, bottle books, etc.). Some small table-top antiques may be sold. All merchandise must be clearly priced. Repros, fake labels, repaired, coated, artificially colored, or irradiated glass **must** be clearly marked as such.

Displays:

The Federation encourages collectors to share their knowledge, enthusiasm, and interests with other collectors by displaying their collections. There will be no charge for Exhibitor Displays. Those **setting up a display** will be provided an **Early Admission Pass** which will allow full show privileges to them, their spouse, and minor children or a free \$30 ad in the souvenir program

Non-competitive ribbons will be presented to people's choice, dealer's choice, and "most educational". (See contract pages for further information). In fairness to the individual collector, group displays (while highly encouraged) do not qualify for the non-competitive ribbons.

Early Admission:

Early admission is for non-dealers that would like the privilege of buying early at the show with the dealers. The early admission fee will be \$60 for individuals or a family couple (including minor children). This price includes a complimentary souvenir program. Discounted cost for early admission to National Shows is another privilege of FOHBC membership. The discounted rate for current, **paid-up** Federation members as of the show date is \$45.

Dealer & Exhibitor Registration Packets:

Your registration packets and complementary souvenir program will be available in the South Exhibit Hall Lobby. (See the Schedule of Events page for times.) No one will be allowed in the showroom without an exhibitor or dealer tag.

Dealer Unloading:

The loading/unloading docks are located on the front side of the Exhibit Hall. Unloading will be Saturday, June 25th from 8:00 am to 11 am. During this time dealers will be permitted to unload their merchandise and place it in the show area behind or under their sales table(s). Shelving, lighting, and banners may be set up at this time. Electrical outlets are available upon request for \$10. All items for sale must be kept in closed boxes. No sales are allowed during the "unloading" period.

Exhibitor Set Up:

Exhibitors may set up their displays during the dealer "unloading" period. Tables, white cloth table covers, and electrical outlets are available at no charge. The exhibitor must supply his own extension cord and accent lighting.

Clearing the Showroom:

Everyone will be cleared out of the showroom at noon on Saturday. It will be locked from 12:00 noon until 1:00 pm for final show preparation.

Dealer Set Up & Early Admission:

All dealers will be admitted into the showroom promptly at 1:00 pm Saturday, to allow them to arrive at their tables for setup ahead of the early admission group. Early Admission will be allowed in immediately behind the dealers. Your **own** Dealer/Early Admission name tags **must** be worn visibly to gain access to the showroom.

The Big Show

Admission time for Sunday will be 8:00 for dealers and early buyers. The general public will be admitted at 9:00 am. General admission will be \$5. The show will end at 3:00 pm. **All dealers must remain set up until 3:00** in courtesy to the public who have come many miles to be there. This is their day, let's make it enjoyable for them!

Memphis Cook Convention Center

The convention center is a **non-smoking** facility. We ask your cooperation in abiding by their rules and regulations. They provide ample free parking.

Cancellations:

Requests for refunds must be made by June 10, 2011. Refunds for circumstances outside your control after that time will be at the discretion of the show chairman.

Every effort will be made to safeguard the sales and exhibit areas. Security guards will be on duty at all times during the unloading, the show, after show hours, and the loading period, however, the FOHBC, its officers, or agents assume no liability or responsibility for any lost, stolen, or damaged merchandise.

Decisions concerning any circumstances not outlined in the "Rules & General Information" or contract will be made by the Show Chairman, or, in his absence, by the local Memphis representative (Gene Bradberry).
