This contract is between the National Bottle Museum (NBM) and the primary dealer whose signature is on the contract. Dealers agree to hold harmless the NBM, and its individual members from loss of or damage to the dealer's property by theft, and/or accidental causes. Furthermore, dealer agrees to release above mentioned parties from responsibility for bodily or personal injury to the dealer, members of his/her family, employees or agents. The National Bottle Museum reserves the right to accept or reject any request for sales table space.

PRICE: 8 foot sales table-\$45 for the first table, \$40 each additional table.
Outdoor space - \$40/lot - dealer supplies tent, table, chairs, etc.

MOVE IN TIME: 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM on **SATURDAY** June 2nd, 2018. Security will be provided.
6:30 AM to 8:00 AM on **SUNDAY** June 3rd, 2018

DEALERS: No more than two dealers at a table. Only Dealers, Exhibitors,
and their pre-registered Assistants allowed on premises during
set-up time. Only one pre-registered Assistant per table unless prior
arrangements have been made. Assistants will not be allowed at shared tables.
Everyone will be required to wear the proper identification tag provided at the
door. Tags will be given to Dealers only, and they will be responsible for
providing the tag to their Assistant. Children will also be required to wear name
tags.

Dealers who loan or give their identification tag to another without informing us
will be removed from our mailing list. Security for your property is our major
concern. If you have any problem, please talk to us.

SECURITY: Dealers are ultimately responsible for the security of their own items and are
encouraged to have their table attended at all times. NBM members will also
provide a security watch throughout the day.

TABLES: Tables will be assigned on a first come, first served basis as noted on the postmark on the returned contract. Confirmation of your table number will be mailed approximately two weeks prior to the show. You are responsible for providing your own table cover. Electricity is **NOT** available to every table. Dealers who reserve a table must set up and remain until 2:30 PM.

MERCHANDISE: All types of bottles, jars, and related items, insulators, stoneware, marbles, ephemera, breweriana, etc. are acceptable for inside tables. All reproductions, fictitious labels, artificially colored or repaired items must be clearly marked.

Outdoor table merchandise may include table-top wares, antiques or collectibles (no toys) souvenir china, advertising, and postcards, are acceptable. No large items (i.e. furniture or rugs). Please inquire about different or unrelated items.

PAYMENT: All contracts must be accompanied by full payment. Please make checks payable to: National Bottle Museum. Phone reservations will not be honored until full payment has been collected. Table rental fee is not refundable after May 18th, 2018.
